Many spend up to half of their income on thekerosene, even though it provides inadequate illumination.(2)Kerosene is also responsible for 1.5 million deaths from burns andrespiratory illnesses annually(3) -- 62 percent of which arechildren.(4) Further, each kerosene lamp emits more than 100kg ofcarbon every year, adding up to 190 million tons of global carbonemissions annually.(5)

"The solar-powered LED lanterns and bulbs donated by Energizer areinvaluable to these rural communities," said Anna Sidana, founder of One Million Lights. "Safe and healthy solar lighting not only savesmoney and lives, but it also gives these families the opportunity towork, study and play when they otherwise could not."
